Level II fieldwork in Hand Therapy is a great way to learn more about being a hand therapist and shows potential employers your interest in the field.

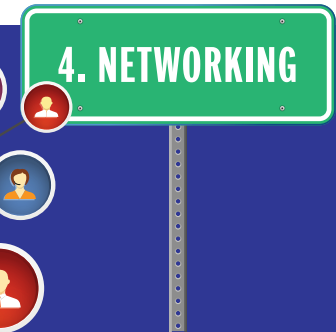


Post professional fellowships allow therapists to gain experience in hand therapy. Many fellowships are a year long and may also be paid.



Finding an experienced hand therapist or a Certified Hand Therapist (CHT) to mentor you is one of the best ways to learn about the profession of hand therapy.

Joining a local or national hand therapy membership organization like the American Society of Hand Therapists is an excellent way to meet other therapists and to find potential career opportunities.



Attending local, national, and online hand therapy continuing education is essential in learning about the art and science of hand therapy.

Ask a local CHT in your area or hand surgeon if you can shadow them or help out in the clinic. Observing therapists and surgeons in action is invaluable.
